- > Funding priorities based on students' needs



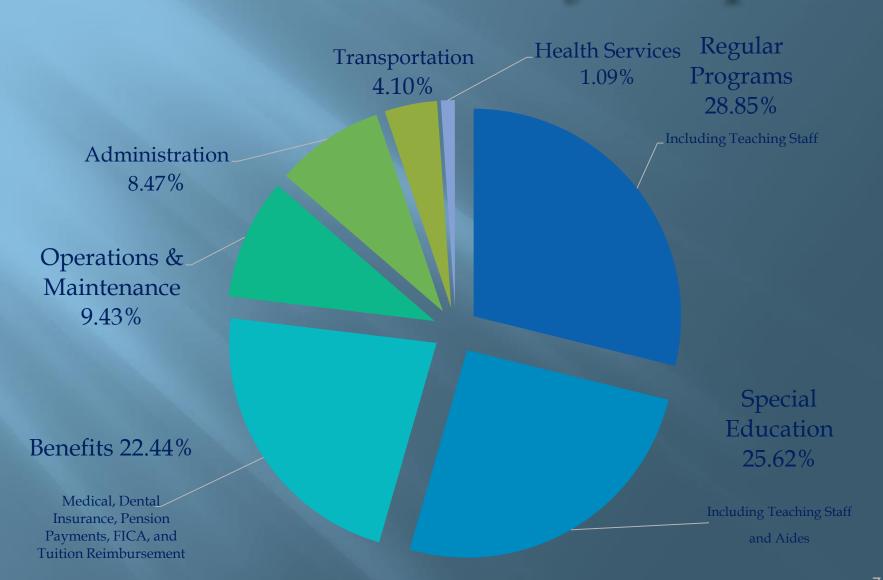
