- Results of Demographic Report used to:
 - Determine impact of new construction and sale of existing home sales on student enrollment
 - ☐ Inform/assist with long-term facility planning
 - \square Classrooms (maintain small class sizes of 18-20)
 - ☐ Classroom space for all special subject areas
 - ☐ Small Instruction space
 - ☐ Offices for related service providers
 - Storage

Possible Future Development Greenbrook Country Club

- ☐ 160 age-restricted stacked condo/townhouse units
- 89-99 market-rate townhouses units cannot have more than three bedrooms
- 50 affordable 1, 2 and 3 bedroom apartments (half of these units would be age restricted for seniors)
- □ 80-130 beds for assisted living

To avoid over-estimating future enrollment, the demographic report did not include the potential number of children from GBCC

Inward Migration

- ☐ The demographic report reviewed enrollment data over the past ten years.
- Data indicated a trend toward "inward migration" of students
- Inward migration occurs when families with school-aged children purchase an existing or new home within the district.
